From Morrisville: Take Rt. 20 WEST, go approx. 3 miles and turn LEFT on Willowvale. . . The rest is the same.

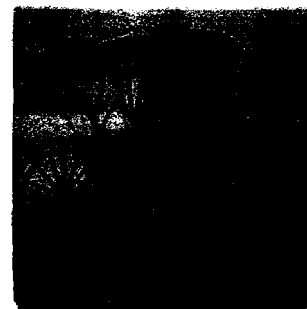
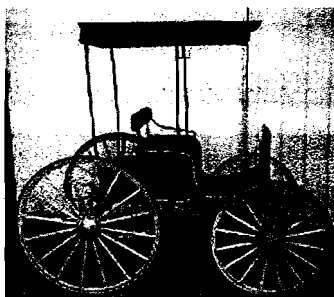
After lunch, we hitched up "**Buster**," **Sandy Parizo's** faithful horse, for obstacle training. Every-
